## Just for Kids!

### Sandi Cruikshank's Challenge:

A \$30 cash prize will be awarded to the Junior Exhibitor with the Most Entries in Division 30.

#### Rules:

- Only 1 entry per exhibitor per class.
- Juniors may enter above their age section but not below, for example – an 8-year old can compete in the 13 Years & Under classes.
- In the 'Flowers' category, use fresh flowers and plant materials only. To ensure they stay fresh throughout the Exhibition, display them in a container with water. No artificial flowers to be used.
- All pictures in the 'Fine Arts' category must be framed and ready to hang with wire attached to the back of the frame.
- Maximum size for 'Fine Arts' is 16" x 20" [41cm x 51cm].

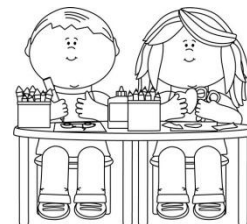
