Championship classes: Rosettes only. Champion and Reserve Champion rosettes will be awarded to the top two entries overall in each category’s Showmanship and Project Sections.

Register between July 17th and Aug. 26th. Last day to register: August 26th, by 5 pm. Deliver or mail the entry form to Cowichan Exhibition, 7380 Trans Canada Hwy, Duncan, BC V9L 6B1.

Arrival Times: All 4-H exhibits must be in place by 5:30 pm, Thursday, Sept. 7th.

Departure Times: After 4:15 pm, Sunday, Sept. 10th.

Rules:

- BC 4-H Project Regulations apply. All ages are 4-H ages.
- The 4-H entry form must be completed by the Club Leader.
- 4-H CLASSES – open to 4-H members only.
- OPEN CLASSES – club members may also enter their 4-H animals in the Open show but must complete the regular Livestock entry form and pay the regular entry fee.
- Hay & bedding will be provided for 4-H livestock clubs.
- Two members from each club will be designated to look after their club’s entries. ‘Stall duty’ includes supervision of those entries at all times plus distribution of hay/bedding, etc.
- 4-H barns must be left clean at the end of the Fair.
- In Showmanship classes, members must show their own project. Judging will be based on 50% for fitting and 50% for showmanship. Questions may be asked. Members must compete in Showmanship for their projects to be eligible for conformation judging.
- Interclub Competition shall consist of 3 or more groups of the same project. Each group must have 4 animals and 4 handlers plus 1 or 2 members to set up the animals and answer the judge’s questions. Each group will be judged on the uniformity of the animals, the presentation of the members, plus showmanship.
- Achievement prize money is determined by the year’s marks which include points gained in ring placing.

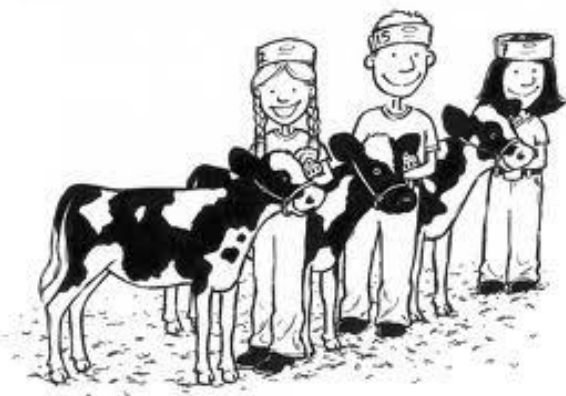
