Delivery of Exhibits: Thursday, Sept. 6th – between 10 am and 5:30 pm. Bring exhibits to Poultry Barn; they must be in place by 6 pm for judging.

Pick Up of Exhibits: Sunday, Sept. 9th – after 4 pm.

If unable to collect your exhibit(s) by 6 pm that day, the Exhibition is open the following week from 9 am to 5 pm.

3-Day Exhibitor's Pass: \$17. The regular gate entry fee for adults is \$10-\$12/day.

Enter them in our new 'Fresh Eggs' classes! We've got classes for Painted Eggs and Decorated Eggs too.



Section 1: Fresh Eggs – Open to all ages

NEW! Fresh Eggs to be exhibited in groups of 3 except as noted in classes 11 and 12. Plates and shavings will be supplied for display. Eggs will be judged on freshness, shell quality, shape, size, cleanliness, internal quality (one egg will be broken open) and the uniformity of the group. When registering, please note the breed of fowl that produced the eggs (not required for classes 11 and 12).

- 2 Large – 3 chicken eggs
- 3 Medium – 3 chicken eggs
- 4 Small – 3 chicken eggs
- 5 Bantam – 3 chicken eggs
- 6 Waterfowl – 3 eggs
- 7 Quail – 3 eggs
- 8 Turkey – 3 eggs
- 9 Game – 3 eggs
- 10 AOV – 3 eggs
- 11 Smallest egg – 1 only
- 12 Largest egg – 1 only

Section 2: Painted Eggs – Open to all ages

NEW! Entry to be hard boiled or blown, painted or inked by the exhibitor. No applied decorations. The exhibitor is responsible for supplying any necessary support for display.

- 13 One egg, painted or inked
- 14 Group of eggs, painted or inked

Section 3: Decorated Eggs – Open to all ages

NEW! Entry to be hard boiled or blown. Egg(s) are to be decorated by the exhibitor and may also be painted or inked. Remember to maintain the outline of the egg so the egg shape is recognizable no matter what design is chosen. The exhibitor is responsible for supplying any necessary support for display.
