Decoration class (daily prize: 1st - \$20). Driving: Prize money
will be paid out in all classes.

Register between July 17th and Aug. 26th. Last day to
register: August 26th, by 5 pm. Mail or deliver entry forms to
the Cowichan Exhibition, 7380 Trans Canada Hwy, Duncan,
B.C V9L 6B1. Forms without payment will not be processed.

Post Entries - \$25/entry surcharge: Space permitting from
Sun., Aug. 27th - 5 pm, Tues., Sept. 5th. **No entries on the day.**

Light Horse Show Rules & Regulations:

- A separate entry form must be completed for each horse/rider combination entered.
- All exhibitors must be HCBC members - www.hcbc.ca.
- For class descriptions and judging criteria, please refer to HCBC General Performance Rulebook. Complete rules are published on the Horse Council BC website.
- Should any question or dispute arise, not provided for in the Rules, it shall be referred to the Chairperson whose decision shall be final.
- If a class is not filled to the satisfaction of the show management, classes may be combined or cancelled.
- Exhibitors cancelling their entries after the deadline shall forfeit their entry fees, except in case of disability, when 75% of fees shall be refunded on presentation of a disability certificate from a Veterinarian and/or Doctor. Application for refunds must be made before the closing day of the show to the Chairperson of the Cowichan Exhibition Light Horse Show.
- The Chairperson reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Approved equestrian helmets are compulsory while mounted or driving anywhere on the grounds other than adults riding in Section 2 Open Western Classes who may wear a western hat or approved riding helmet. Youth or Junior competitors must wear properly fitted, approved BSI or ASTM protective headgear with safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted, riding or driving on the event grounds.
- Camping is permitted in the livestock trailer parking area. Note: There are NO hookups or washrooms in that area.

- Vehicles and/or trailers are not permitted on the show grounds between 9 am and 4 pm for loading and unloading, for safety reasons. An area is designated for livestock trailer parking. Contact the Chairperson if you have any questions.
- All horses on the grounds overnight must be stabled. Day stalls are also available. Stabling is free of charge with a \$25 Clean Stall Deposit as a separate cheque payable to 'Cowichan Exhibition'. Indicate approximate arrival and departure time on the entry form so a stall may be assigned. First come, first served.
- Please be ready for your classes. Check with the Show Office as the show progresses.
- No stallions to be ridden/driven by a Junior.
- Juniors may enter Open classes.
- A warm up area will be designated within the main competition ring. No lunging permitted.
- Exhibitors may purchase a 3-Day Exhibitor's Pass (\$15) when delivering their entry form. Limit: 1 per exhibitor. Single day passes are available for \$10 each. No limit.
- 4-H Horse: see Division 10 – 4-H Clubs.

SCORING: 1st - 5 pts, 2nd - 3 pts, 3rd - 2 pts, 4th - 1 pt
Classes with fewer than 5 entries will count half points.

NOTE: 4-H classes do not count for these awards.

Most successful Rider/Horse in the Jumper Division
2'6" and 2'9" classes to count

BATTY CHALLENGE TROPHY

1st Place Junior Rider in Western Horsemanship
(3 or more entries required)

Most successful Driver/Horse

\$50 PRIZES

Open only to Junior riders (riders eligible until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 18). Classes are open to horses and ponies unless specified otherwise.

- 9** Command (English and Western)

Section 2: Open Western & English

All classes open to horses and ponies, Adults and Juniors. Ponies may be ridden by adults.
