Horse Council BC General Performance and Summer Games Qualifier Competition.

**Ribbons, Prizes, and Money:** All classes - ribbons to 6<sup>th</sup> place; money: 1<sup>st</sup> - \$20; 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$15; 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$10; 4<sup>th</sup> - \$5. Prize money limited to classes with 5 or more entries.

**EXCEPTIONS:** Costume, Equitation, and Medal classes (ribbons to 6th place and prizes to 3rd place, no prize money) and Stall Decoration class (daily prize: 1st - \$20).

**Entry Form Deadline:** Monday, Aug. 27<sup>th</sup>, by 5 pm.

**Post Entries:** Space permitting (**\$25/entry surcharge**) from Tuesday, Aug. 28 until 5 pm, Saturday, Sept. 1. **No entries after August 28 or entries on the day.**

**Entry Fee:** All classes \$5.

Mail or deliver entry forms with payment (only cheques or cash accepted) to the Cowichan Exhibition, 7380 Trans Canada Hwy, Duncan, B.C V9L 6B1.

Make all cheques payable to 'Cowichan Exhibition'.

**NOTE:** Forms without full payment will not be entered.

## Light Horse Show Rules & Regulations:

- a. A separate entry form must be completed for each horse/rider combination entered.
- b. All exhibitors must be HCBC members - www.hcbc.ca.
- c. For class descriptions and judging criteria, please refer to HCBC General Performance Rulebook. Complete rules are published on the Horse Council BC website.
- d. Should any question or dispute arise not provided for in the Rules, it shall be referred to the Chairperson whose decision shall be final.
- e. If a class is not filled to the satisfaction of the show management, classes may be combined or cancelled.
- f. Exhibitors cancelling their entries after the Aug. 28<sup>th</sup> deadline shall forfeit their entry fees, except in the case of disability, when 75% of fees shall be refunded on presentation of a disability certificate from a Veterinarian and/or Doctor. Application for refunds must be made before the closing day of the show to the Chairperson of the Cowichan Exhibition Light Horse Show.
- g. The Chairperson reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- h. Approved equestrian helmets are compulsory while mounted or driving anywhere on the grounds other than adults riding in Western Classes who may wear a western hat or approved riding helmet. All riders must wear helmets in Games classes. Youth or Junior competitors must wear properly fitted, approved BSI or ASTM protective headgear with safety harness correctly secured at all times while mounted, riding or driving on the event grounds.
- i. Camping is permitted in the livestock trailer parking area. Note: There are NO hookups or washrooms in that area.
- j. Vehicles and/or trailers are not permitted on the show grounds for loading and unloading between 9 am and 4 pm for safety reasons. An area is designated for livestock

trailer parking. Contact the Chairperson if you have any questions.

- k. All horses on the grounds overnight must be stabled. Day stalls may also be available. Stabling is free of charge with a \$25 Clean Stall Deposit as a separate cheque payable to 'Cowichan Exhibition'. Indicate approximate arrival and departure times on the entry form so a stall may be assigned. First come, first served.
- l. Please be ready for your classes. Check with the Show Office as the show progresses.
- m. No stallions to be ridden/driven by a Junior.
- n. Juniors may enter Open classes.
- o. A warm up area will be designated within the main competition ring. No lunging permitted.
- p. Exhibitors may purchase a 3-Day Exhibitor's Pass (\$17) when delivering their entry form. Limit: 1 per exhibitor. Single day passes are available at the gate entrance.
- q. 4-H Horse: see Division 10 – 4-H Clubs.

## SCORING

1<sup>st</sup> - 5 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 3 pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 2 pts, 4<sup>th</sup> - 1 pt

Classes with fewer than 5 entries will count half points.

*NOTE: 4-H classes do not count for these awards.*

(3 or more entries required)

## PINK FAMILY PERPETUAL TROPHY

Most Successful Junior Rider/Horse combination.  
*All classes in Junior Division to count except Games and Costume classes.*

## BUCKERFIELD'S HI POINT JUMPER TROPHY

Most successful Rider/Horse in the Jumper Division  
*2'6" and 2'9" classes to count*

## TOP SHELF FEEDS PERPETUAL TROPHY

Most Successful Rider/Horse - Light Horse Division.  
*Only classes on Saturday and Sunday to count. Games classes are not considered for trophy points.*

## COWICHAN DISTRICT RIDING CLUB JUNIOR HIGH POINT \$50 PRIZES

Most successful Junior Flat and most successful Junior Jumper Horse/Pony Rider combination competing at both the Cobble Hill Fair and the Cowichan Exhibition in Open classes EXCEPT those designated \*\*. Points awarded: 1<sup>st</sup> - 3, 2<sup>nd</sup> - 2, 3<sup>rd</sup> - 1 plus 1 point for every rider entering a class.
