### **RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITORS**

- 1. "Exhibition "shall mean the Cowichan Exhibition held in the year in respect of which the application is made. "Exhibitor" shall mean the person who signs the application together with the person on whose behalf he/she signs.
- 2. Farmers Market Vendors can set up on Friday, Sept.  $17^{th}$ , between 11 am and 5 pm, or Saturday morning from 7:30-9:30am. Vendors must be ready by 9:30 am.
- 3. Booth hours of operation are Saturday 10 am 3 pm and Sunday 10 am 3 pm.
- 4. All products in the Farmers Market must follow the "Make it, Bake it, Grow it Rule"
- 5. All Exhibitor booths shall be kept clean, tidy, and free from rubbish, debris, and unused materials at all times.
- 6. A non-refundable deposit of 50% of total cost must be made at time of entry & paid in full by August1st, 2021.
- 7. Two (2) two day passes are included free of charge for each booth, passes must be picked up from the Exhibition office prior to Friday Sept. 17<sup>th</sup>; Exhibitors will not be allowed access to the Fair without a bracelet. Additional passes are available from the Exhibition office one-day passes are \$9 each.
- 8. No vehicles may be parked on the Exhibition Grounds during the fair.
- 9. Exhibitors, their agents, Employees and Representatives shall operate strictly within the limits of their booth and shall not operate in any such manner as to be a nuisance or annoyance to the public or other Exhibitors.
- 10. No advertising of any kind may be distributed by the Exhibitor outside of his booth nor may advertising matter be distributed which may be considered objectionable in the opinion of the Directors of the Cowichan Exhibition.
- 11. Exhibitors may conduct Free Draws from their booth, providing that all parts of draw tickets used shall have printed thereon the name of the company conducting the draw. Also, that the Exhibition be given the names of the winners. NO solicitation for donations of any kind may be made. "NO RAFFLES ALLOWED!" Without prior permission from the Board of Directors.
- 12. If any Exhibitor requires more electrical power than can be taken from the outlets, all-necessary installations for electrical power supplied to the booth shall be at the expense of the Exhibitor. NO flammable material or open flame is to be used for demonstration.
- 13. All machinery in motion at exhibit liable to cause accident, injury or damage to persons or property coming in contact with, shall be adequately guarded and protected to prevent the public from coming in contact wherewith or from any danger or damage arising there from. NO KEYS to be left in the ignition of Vehicles, Tractors or Machinery.
- 14. Every Exhibitor shall indemnify the Cowichan Exhibition and save the Cowichan Exhibition harmless of all costs, claims, demands, charges and expenses that may incur, or by reason of accidental death or any personal injury or damage to personal property suffered by reason of machinery or other Exhibit used by an Exhibitor. The Exhibitor shall defend any and all actions and pay all legal charges, expenses arising.
- 15. Whereas the Cowichan Exhibition will take reasonable precaution to ensure the safety of property and materials brought upon the Exhibition premises the Exhibition shall not be liable in any way whatsoever for any damage, loss, injury from any cause whatsoever which may be sustained by an Exhibitor.
- 16. It's recommended that the Exhibitor have attendants in their booth for adequate protection of goods on display.
- 17. No Exhibit may be removed or dismantled prior to 3 pm on Sunday, Sept. 19th, 2021.
- 18. Booth rentals spaces are not confirmed until Deposit payment has been paid to the Cowichan Exhibition.
