REGISTER BETWEEN JULY 18th AND SEPT. 2nd. Last day to register: September 2nd, by 5 pm. Register online at www.cowex.ca, click on FAIR 2022 and follow the links. Or register in person in the Office on any week day (9:30 to 4:00).

DELIVERY OF ENTRIES: Please bring all *Hobbies & Crafts* entries to Mellor Hall on Wednesday, Sept. 14th between 10 am and 5:30 pm.

PICK UP OF ENTRIES: Sunday, Sept. 18th – after 4:15 pm. If unable to collect your entries by 6 pm that day, the Exhibition is open the following week from 9:30 am to 4 pm.

PRIZE MONEY: 1st - \$5, 2nd - \$3, 3rd - ribbon only.

Pick up prize money and special awards from the Exhibition Office the week of Sept. 26th to 30th – 9:30 am to 4 pm.

RULES:

- Only 1 entry per exhibitor per class.
- This Division is open to amateurs and professionals. Entrants must not display any material promoting their business with their entries.
- "A.O.V." means Any Other Variety.
- If you wish to enter an item that is larger than average or very valuable, please contact the Chairperson prior to the show.
- The term "medium" refers to the materials used to produce the hobby or craft.
- Exhibitor's Pass: exhibitors may purchase a 3-day pass for \$17. The regular gate fee for adults is \$10-\$12/day.

Section 1: Miscellaneous Classes

- 2022 Theme Challenge: "Jack & the Beanstalk" – a doll inspired by Jack, any craft technique. **1st - \$15 . . . donated by Alison Irwin.**
- 2022 Colour Challenge – Green, Gold & Pantone's Very Peri (a purplish hue): a wearable *non-plastic* piece of jewelry in this year's palette. **1st - \$30 Gift Certificate, 2nd - \$20 Gift Certificate, 3rd - \$10 Gift Certificate . . . sponsored by Island Gem and Bead Supply Ltd., Duncan.**
- Model – from scratch, not a kit. If exhibit is larger than 20" in any dimension, please contact the chairperson regarding table space. **1st - \$12, 2nd - \$10, 3rd - \$8 . . . donated by Dorothy Sjostrom.**
- Model – from a kit.
- Collection (no coins or stamps) – max. size: 24" x 24" (61cm x 61cm), please label. Collection MUST be displayed on a solid base so it can be moved as one unit and it must be covered so that items cannot be removed. The collection must not have been entered in a previous Cowichan Exhibition.
- Christmas craft – any item, any medium
- Halloween craft – any item, any medium
- Holiday craft - any decoration used for any other holiday, such as Kwanzaa, Flag Day, Thanksgiving
- Ceramics (any type) or pottery (wheel thrown)
- Pottery – hand made. **1st - \$12, 2nd - \$10, 3rd - \$8 . . . donated by The Mud Room.**
- "By the Sea" – a decoration made with things from the sea shore, e.g. rocks, shells, driftwood. Accessories allowed.
- Angel – any medium. **1st - \$12, 2nd - \$10, 3rd - \$8 . . . donated by Brenda Campbell.**
- Fairy door – create a small portal for your backyard
- Painted rock
- "A Warm Welcome" – to adorn your front door

- NEW! A Mason bee house. **1st - \$12, 2nd - \$10, 3rd - \$8 . . . donated by Dorothy Sjostrom.**
- NEW! Bean seed art – must be framed
- NEW! Stepping stone -- any technique, i.e. mosaic
- Diamond Dotz or similar product – original design, framed, maximum size 36" x 26" [92cm x 66cm]
- Fly tying – present a fishing fly in a frame
- 'Bernardin' Creative Craft Competition: Homemade craft using Bernardin Mason Jar(s) and/or 2-piece SNAP Lid® - may be decorative or functional. **1st - \$20 Gift Certificate & Rosette . . . sponsored by Bernardin.**
- NEW! Lego, original design – entry must be on a base, max. 15" x 15", with all pieces securely attached
- Hobby or craft – A.O.V. not listed above (please call the chairperson if unsure about appropriate class or size)
- NEW! 3-D printer project – indicate source of design or if design is original. **1st - \$15 . . . donated by Alison Irwin.**
